Reference to lesson plan: Storytelling outdoors; Trees and their parts.

Procedure:

The students were asked to stand in the circle, after that divided into groups of 3-4. Each group was walking in the area. In small groups students has found an object that is interesting but that does not belong in the space and note it. Afterwards students wrote down their stories and presented it. Some have chosen to pretend that they are this object. During the second lesson, students were identifying trees and their parts by using an active language game Autumn Scavenger Hunt.



Results:

For the assessment of what was learned, the students were asked document their observations, reflections, and findings during the outdoor activities. These records were put into their portfolio We going to practice more activities outside, thus, in the end of the course it will be a good source for the reflection of the whole language course.

Everyone were satisfied and asked for more such lessons outside the school. As a teacher I felt more comfortable and confident to have a prepared material with an exact tip what activities to do. I would say that their good behaviour and high motivation has surprised me.
